The sales dates are as follows:

- Prom Expo – Discounted - One night only - March 8th- 1 for \$75 or 2 for \$140
- After prom expo tickets will be sold online ONLY for \$80 a ticket
- Final Day to purchase tickets will be **April 20th**

Important Prom Info:

- To attend prom you must follow the MHS requirements which include:
 - A 2.0 GPA
 - Attendance compliance (No more than 20 absences)
 - Behavior (Students with more than 3 days OSS may NOT attend)
- **Early purchase of a prom ticket DOES NOT guarantee admittance.**
 - **If you purchase a ticket at Prom EXPO and then violate any of the discipline, GPA, or attendance requirements you will NOT be permitted to attend prom and you will NOT receive a refund!**
- Prom is for upperclassmen: Seniors and Juniors. **A Sophomore or Freshman student can only attend prom if he/she is the date of a Senior or Junior.**
- Any necessary changes will be announced on Middleburg 411.
- No guests over the age of 20 by May 6th, 2017 may attend prom.
- **NO REFUNDS FOR PROM TICKETS** unless the student withdraws from MHS.
- ALL students **MUST** have a picture ID to pick up Prom tickets.
- No one will be allowed to re-enter prom after leaving.
- All MHS students **MUST** have a prom ticket and a picture ID to enter prom.
- If you buy two prom tickets, please see Mrs. Alt or Mrs. McGuffin **No later than April 21st** to give the name of your date/guest.
- All non-MHS guests **MUST** have a prom ticket and a picture ID.
 - Non-MHS students must be pre-approved.
- Seniors pick up prom tickets: **Wednesday, May 3rd, during Bronco Nation in portable 43.**
- Juniors pick up prom tickets: **Thursday, May 4th, during Bronco Nation in portable 43.**

Prom Attire:

Gentlemen: MUST wear a FORMAL tuxedo.

Tuxedos should be ordered as soon as possible to ensure color and style choice.

Michael's Formalwear at the Orange Park Mall is offering discount coupons for tuxedos.

Ladies: MUST wear a FORMAL dress. This is not homecoming! No short dresses allowed

- If your dress is a high low OR has a sheer overlay skirt the under skirt may not be higher than 3 inches above the knee. (the post-it note rule)
- If your dress has a slit in it then it may not be higher than 3 inches above the knee.
- Two pieces are allowed but may only be a 1 inch space between skirt and top.
- Backless dresses cannot go below waist level (not hip level).
- No plunging necklines.
- If a student fails to meet dress code requirements, he/she will be asked to leave prom.
- **Failure to meet the dress code requirements will result in non-admittance and NO REFUND will be given.**

Non-MHS Guest Approval Form: (this is different from last year)

Administration makes final decision in regards to guest approval.

Financial Obligations:

All financial obligations must be paid before purchasing a prom ticket.

Any newly-acquired financial debts must be paid before prom tickets can be picked up.

Attendance Policy:

Students who are absent 20 or more days (10 in the first semester) are subject to exclusion from extracurricular activities (i.e. athletics, co-curricular activities and competitions, Prom, Grad Night, etc.).

Discipline Policy

Students who have more than 3 Days of OSS or have more than 3 discipline referrals of a level of 2 or 3 are subject to exclusion from Prom.

Selling Prom Tickets to Another MHS Student:
